CALL TO ORDER

Chairman, Dolores Schwertner, announced the presence of a quorum and called the regular meeting of the Regional Advisory Committee on Aging (RACOA) to order at 10:07 a.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the March 28, 2018 RACOA meeting were reviewed and approved.

TEXAS SILVER HAIRED LEGISLATURE (TSHL) REPORT

Member Sherry Hubbard provided an update on the TSHL Directory. Copies are available at the AAA. Biennial Legislative session of the Texas Silver Haired Legislature was held April 22nd-26th, 2018. Legislative report containing ten highest voted Resolutions will be distributed to Governor Abbott and the Texas legislators prior to the 2019 Texas Legislative Session. The date of distribution will be voted on during July's Texas Silver Haired Legislature Executive Committee meeting. Member Wayne Merrill further discussed Legislative session. Reminded the committee that there are still seats available for individuals interested in representing TSHL for the Concho Valley region. Spoke about implementation of scantrons in the TSHL voting process on Resolutions

AREA AGENCY ON AGING (AAA) DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Director Roberts provided updates on the following:

Older American's Month 2018 - Discussed handouts. President's address regarding May 2018 being declared Older American's month, read by Chair Dolores Schwertner.

FY 18 Planning Budget - Approved 04/24/18. "Carry Over" term gone away, now referred to as "Continuation Funds".

FY 17 Closeout update - due to changes/turnover at the State level, the Closeout process has been delayed. Last communication from HHS 5/17/18.

Stress Busting /EBI program updates - discussed only having two classes left in the ongoing session of the Stress Busting course. This program requires 4-6 caregiver participants for the class to be held. The AAA has asked members to continue to promote the program and assist the AAA in recruitment for program participation.

Senior Source book 2018 - Released in May 20th issue of Standard Times. Received 8,000 copies available for distribution. 400-500 hundred copies to be delivered to Meals for the Elderly for dispersal to clients of their services.

Introduction of AAA Administrative Assistant, Crystalin Pattillo.

Power in Community (PIC) Event - Concho Valley was one of three AAA's chosen by the state to hold this event in 2018. Event to be held August 22nd. Target of 80 attendees. PIC advents aid to educate the public about Medicare in general; Medicare preventive, fraud, MSP, low income subsides, and MIPPA. Other AAA's chosen: Wichita Falls & El Paso.

OTHER BUSINESS / ANNOUNCEMENTS

RACOA meeting schedule for 2018 distributed.

Handouts describing services the AAA provides including staff person tied to each program. IR&A description hand out. Referrals to continue to go through Information Specialist first.

Dana Sercos announced Virtual dementia tours; intended for family members or caregivers (informal or formal) to gain insight on the experience of having Alzheimer's. Tours will be held at Springhill Suites on June 8th, 15th, & 22nd from 10am-3pm.
